LSI will assist people with disabilities or disadvantages achieve greater independence and self-esteem through vocational training and employment opportunities.

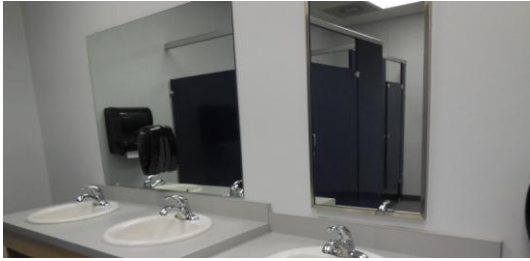
